PER CURIAM:

Appellant challenges the Land Court's conclusions that Telungalek ra Idong ("Idong Lineage") owns Lot 181 - 083A and the Children of Ngirboketereng Merep own Lot 181 - 083B, both of which are depicted on Worksheet 2005 B 04. Having reviewed the record, we find that the Land Court made no errors of law and that its findings of fact were not clearly erroneous. Accordingly, the Land Court's Determinations of Ownership in favor of Idong Lineage and the Children of Ngirboketereng Merep are **AFFIRMED**.
