On April 29, 1993, Trial Counselor John O. Ngiraked was convicted of murder. His conviction was affirmed on appeal on January 8, 1996. On February 22, 1996, the court issued an Order to Show Cause why respondent should not be disbarred pursuant to **1200** Rules 2(a) and (3) of the Disciplinary Rules And Procedures For Attorneys And Trial Counselors Practicing In The Courts Of the Republic Of Palau. On March 13, 1996, respondent filed an Answer in response to the Order To Show Cause. Respondent's Answer, however, provides no reason why he should not be disbarred for commission of an act of moral turpitude.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that respondent John O. Ngiraked be disbarred and his name stricken from the roll of trial counselors licensed to practice in the Republic of Palau.
